The expansive region is divided into the Left Bank and the Right Bank and 89% of all wine made in Bordeaux is red.

Learn more about why these wines are so popular. What grapes make a Bordeaux? We will be tasting some wines from both the Left & Right Bank and, in addition, we will also to be trying a non-French Bordeaux wine.
